This is where all distances to Perth are measured, representing the centre and historic heart of the city. As part of our initiative to celebrate local produce, we have calculated exactly how near each of our Western Australian suppliers are to our venue.

### WESTERN AUSTRALIAN AFTERNOON TEA 70

*served with tea or coffee and a glass of Singlefile Great Southern Sparkling NV*

*Singlefile Wines, Denmark WA  
413km south of Point Zero*

### SIGNATURE AFTERNOON TEA 80

*served with tea or coffee and a glass of Taittinger Brut Réserve NV*

*Champagne Taittinger, Reims, France  
14,155km north-west of Point Zero*

*Served daily between 2.00pm and 5.00pm.  
Reservations required with a minimum of 24 hours notice.  
Afternoon Tea available year-round. Menu changes seasonally.*

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### **Smoked chicken, green olive tapenade and roasted almond on white bread**

*Free range chicken from Mount Barker, WA  
360km south of Point Zero*

Located in the Great Southern region, Mount Barker chickens are free to roam the land, known for its pristine environment and pure water.

### **Brie, salami, rocket and apple, on a baguette**

*Double cream brie from Metricup, WA  
252km southwest of Point Zero*

The Margaret River Dairy Company's origins date back to 1966 when a group of Italian cheesemakers began selling their farmhouse cheeses in a small store in Perth. In 1990 they moved to the southwest, well known for its rich soil and green pastures, and have gone from strength to strength ever since.

### **Smoked salmon madeleines, 'fromage à la crème'**

*Green and red capsicum from Carnarvon WA  
906km northwest of Point Zero*

*Carnarvon sits on the doorstep of Shark Bay, a world heritage site. With Exmouth and Ningaloo Reef to the north, the warm weather in the region provides the perfect conditions for some of the best quality capsicums in Australia.*

### **'Paris-Brest pistache fraise' — pistachio mousseline, strawberry whipped ganache, almond and fresh strawberries**

*Strawberries from Bullsbrook, WA  
44km north of Point Zero*

Established in the early 1990s, the Berry Sweet Strawberry Farm is a much loved family business well known for its flavoursome hand-harvested strawberries.

### **'Exotique à la mangue' 'Exotique à la mangue' 'noix de coco' — coconut dacquoise, coconut croustillant, mango crémeux, coconut mousse**

*Mango from Kununurra, WA  
3214km north-east of Point Zero*

Located on the eastern edge of the Kimberley region, the iconic agricultural town of Kununurra was the backdrop for the movie *Australia* and is also well known for juicy, tender mangoes.

### **'Biscuit de Noël à la confiture de thé et de fruits secs' — milk chocolate mousse, Christmas tea-infused dried fruit compôte, speculoos**

*Apricots from Donnybrook, WA  
199km south of Point Zero*

Located near the Preston River, Donnybrook is the centre of apple production in Western Australia and also boasts some of the sweetest golden apricots in Australia.
